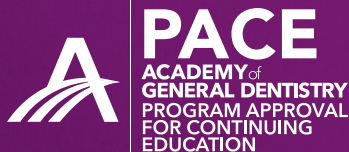

LECTURE WITH HANDS-ON WORKSHOP: ANTERIOR MIDDLE SUPERIOR ALVEOLAR (AMSA) ANESTHETIC TECHNIQUE

1.5 or 4 CE CREDITS This lecture and hand-on workshop is designed for hygienists who are licensed to provide local anesthetic while hygienists who are not licensed to provide local anesthetic may attend the lecture only. The AMSA technique is a newer injection technique that may improve patient treatment when paired with the posterior superior alveolar (PSA) injection to anesthetize a maxillary quadrant while eliminating anesthesia to the soft tissues of the upper lip and face. Thus, it may be beneficial to patients returning to work after treatment or minimizing anesthetic effects for cosmetic procedures. The hands-on portion will prepare you to perform this simple injection along with understanding the newest advances in local anesthesia. To accommodate the group, participants will be able to choose taking either the Friday morning or Saturday morning session. Please contact Amanda for specific course requirements.
